


Chief Executive Officer/President - Abraham Bah, P.E.


The Resource Center was designed to take the shape if the letter "H", representing **hope** for peace and prosperity that every Grand Gedean has after the Liberian brutal civil war.

There is a symbolic female monument standing in a water fountain weaving to visitors approaching the Center. This symbolizes the Grand Gedeh women in the USA, separated by water – the Atlantic Ocean – weaving and welcoming Grand Gedeans to the Center.




The project was designed to be constructed in phases by engineering the master plan to enable the complex to be operational as phases are complete.


